## INSTRUCTOR EXPERIENCE

### How to Access

Click on  to get started.

Instructors do not need an access code for MLL. If you have used other F.A. Davis products in the past, your *DavisPlus* credentials let you access Medical Language Lab.

## INSTRUCTOR DASHBOARD

This is your point of entry every time you log into the MLL. To return to the “Dashboard” at any time, click the MLL logo in the left-hand corner of the screen.

## CREATE A CLASS

You can easily create a class in under 30 seconds.

1. Begin by clicking this button. 
2. Fill-in the class title, description, start date, and end date.
3. Then, click this button

## CUSTOMIZE A LESSON AND VIEW AN ACTIVITY



Now that you have a class created, you are now ready to customize a lesson.

(If you returned to your Dashboard, click  to enter your newly created class.)

1. From the breadcrumbs at the top of the Class Management Wizard select Lesson Settings.

Class Management Wizard: 1: Create Class > 2: Pretest Settings > **3: Lesson Settings** > [Test Settings](#)

You can use the first drop-down menu to navigate to any lesson, but let’s just use the first lesson to learn how you customize any of the lessons.

2. Change the start date to tomorrow’s date. Set the due date for 5 days from the start date.
3. Check the box to set “Generation Exercises” as a “Group Assignment.”
4. Under “Generation,” change the assignment end date to 10 days from the start date.
5. Open “Response” and click on “Exercise 1.” “Response Exercise 1” opens in a new window. You may evaluate each exercise in the MLL in this manner.
6. De-select Response Exercise 1 to exclude it from the lesson.
7. Click on either of the red buttons at the bottom to save your work.  
8. To view your customized class as your students will see it, select

## DELETE A CLASS


You can always start over.


